Bobcat Bolt and Book Fair Funds Raised

- Bobcat Bolt: \$86,310
 - Will fund the shade structure at the biker/walker/golf cart area for students and staff
 - Will fund landscaping improvements to the fields
- Book Fair: ~\$22,600 (total sales). We see roughly 50% of this.
 - Will help fund Scholastic book sets for all classrooms in the 2022-2023 school year and some Scholastic magazines.

Elections Process Update

- The school and community rely on the PTO for:
 - \$18,000 in technology
 - \$15,000 in teachers grants
 - \$13,000 in personal/professional development
 - \$15,000 in summer planning expenses*
 - \$15,000 in teacher appreciation
 - **TOTAL: \$76,000 that the school and community rely on the PTO to help cover.**
- Partners in Education brought in ~\$45,000 this year and membership brought in ~\$20,000. We make this difference up in other areas.
- The PVA PTO is an important piece of the PVA school community.

MEETING MINUTES:

- 1.) Quorum is present
- 2.) Partners in Education Update
 - a. Welcome Party Time Designs as an in-kind sponsor- donated the balloon arch at the Bobcat Bolt
 - b. We have received good response for the survey. We will use this to build the program for next year. We have a new chair and Jodi will work with her and President and Treasurer to get going and start renewals. We will share partner benefits with anyone who wants to learn about it.
 - c. We have 3 partners for Spring Bingo- Springo. They will have tables and items to entertain guests as they arrive and will call numbers.
 - d. Teacher appreciation is coming in May. She will work with chair and partners as that starts.
 - e. 5th Grade celebration- will work with partners as it gets closer.
- 3.) Fundraisers
 - a. Bobcat Bolt raised \$86,310- will fund shade structure and landscaping.
 - b. Bookfair- raised \$22,600 total sales. We see roughly 50% in scholastic dollars- will fund Sunshine State books for classrooms for next year and possibly some magazines.
- 4.) Election Process
 - a. Elections will be held April 11th. The Ballot is listed for those running. Bio information will be up on the PTO website in the coming weeks. Over zoom. Participants will get a survey monkey link. They need to be on the zoom meeting to vote.
 - b. School and Community rely on the PTO for 18,000 in technology, 15,000 in teacher grants, 13,000 in personal/professional development, 15,000 for summer planning expenses, and 15,000 teacher appreciation. Total of \$76,000 the school and community rely on the PTO to cover. PIE brought in \$45,000 and Membership brought in \$20,000 and we make up the rest as we can.
