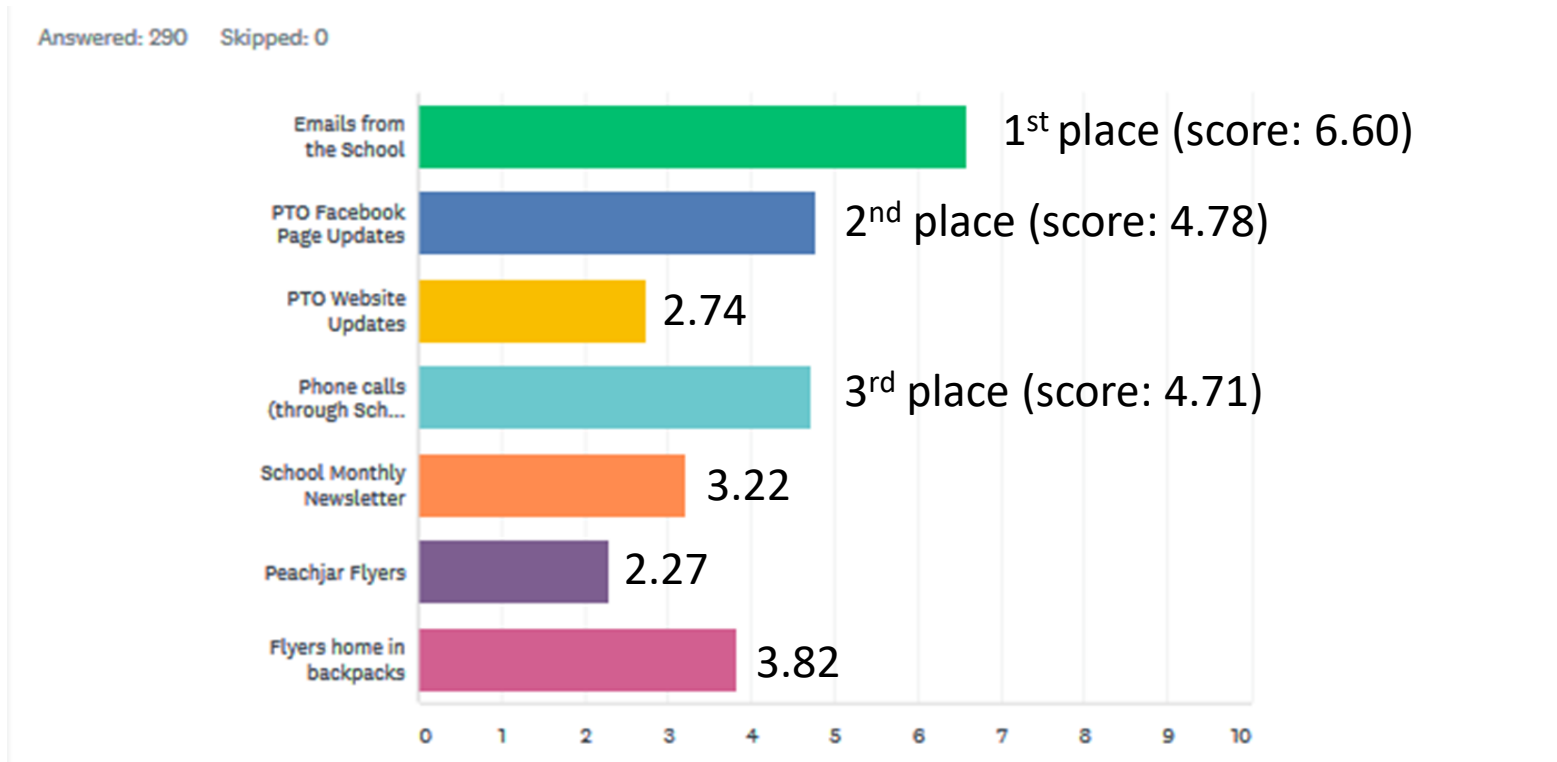

What method is most effective for us to communicate important PTO and school information to you?

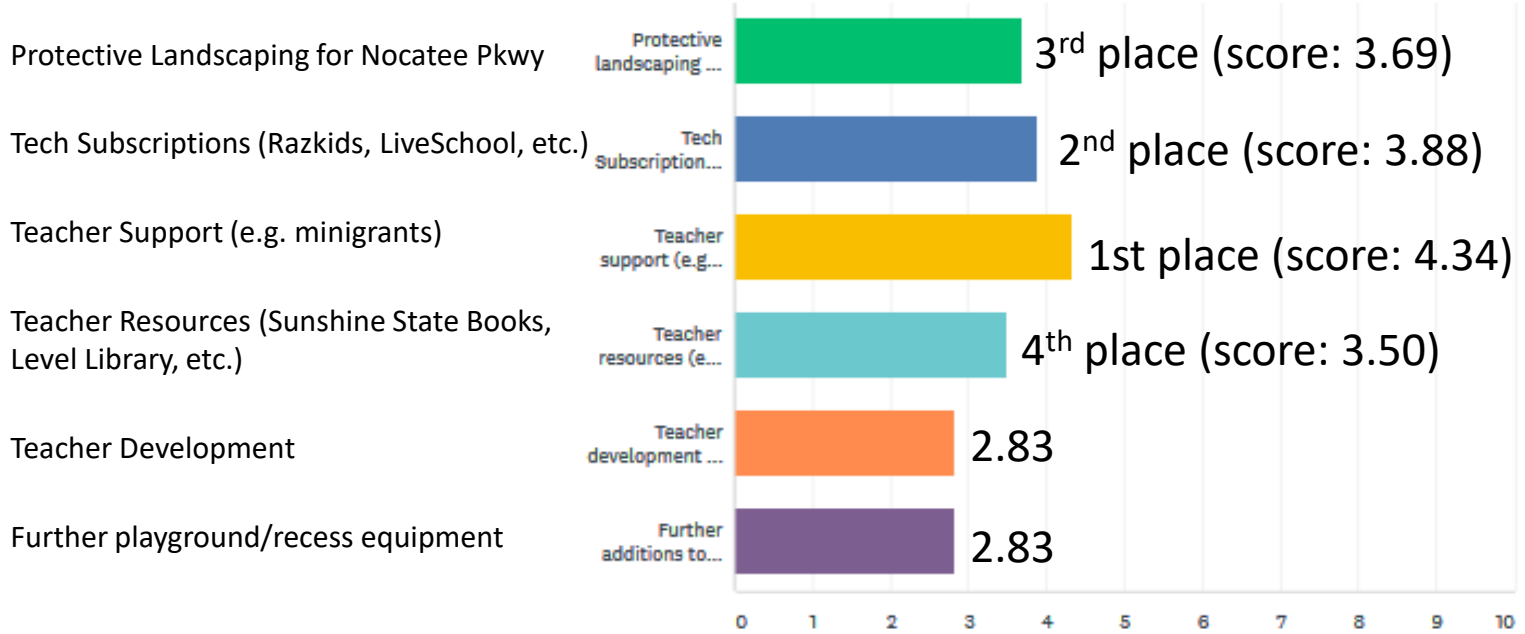




# High Level Fundraising Priorities

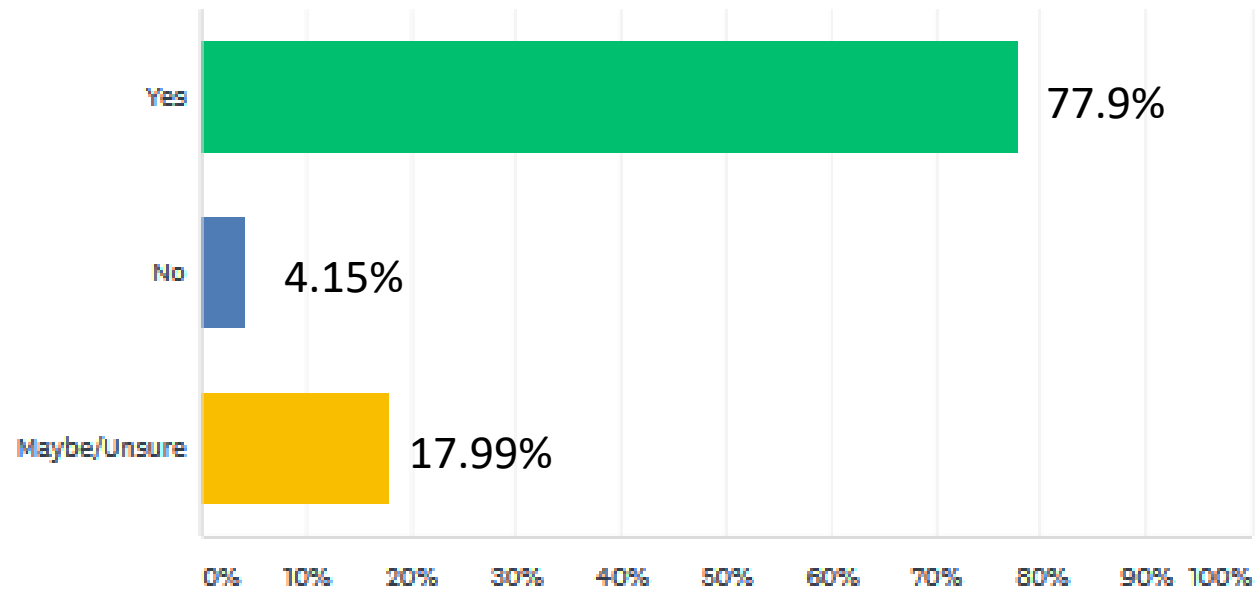




# Membership

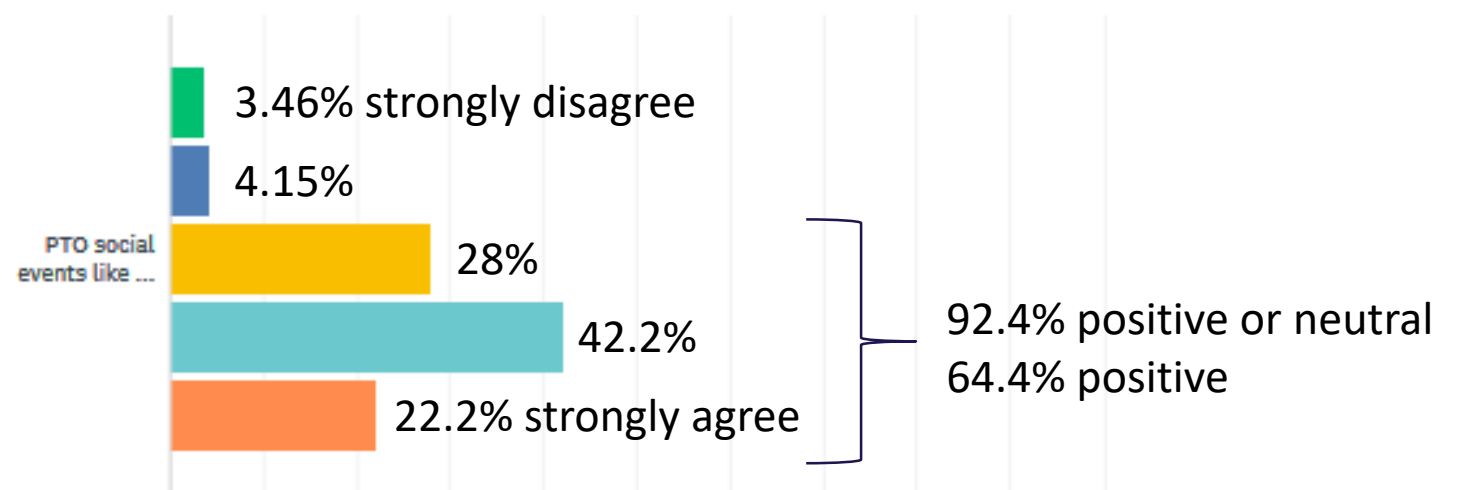




# Opportunity to Socialize with PVA Families

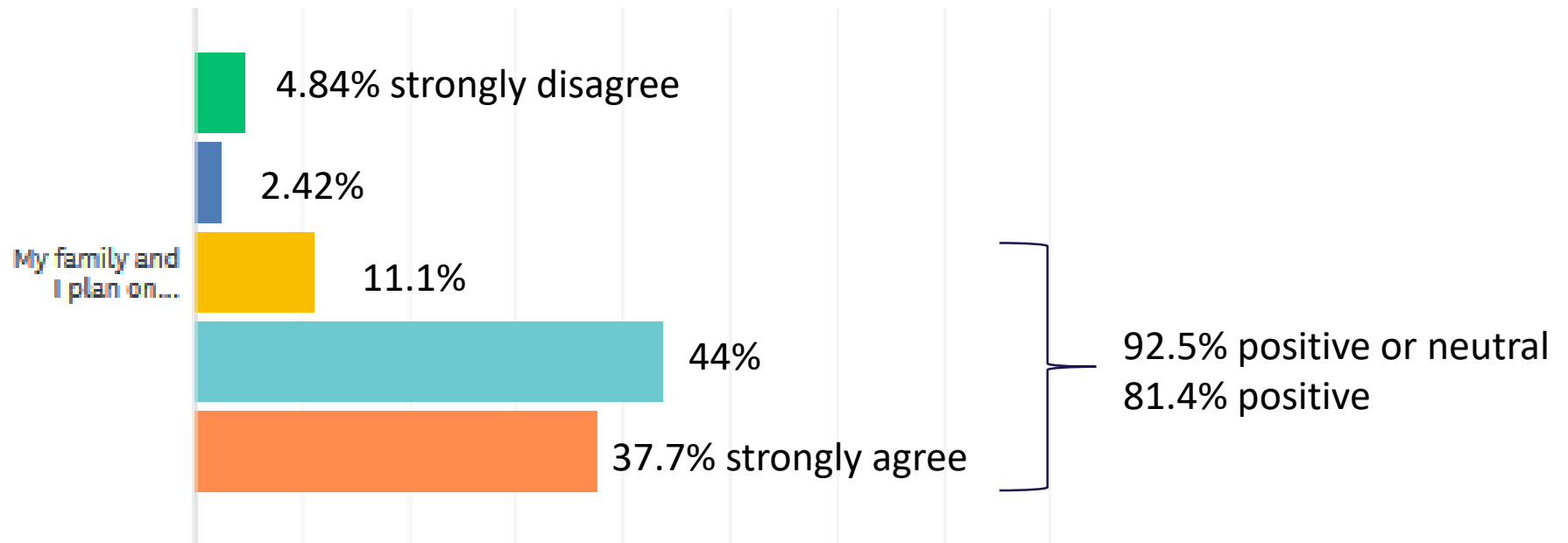




# Likelihood of Event Attendance

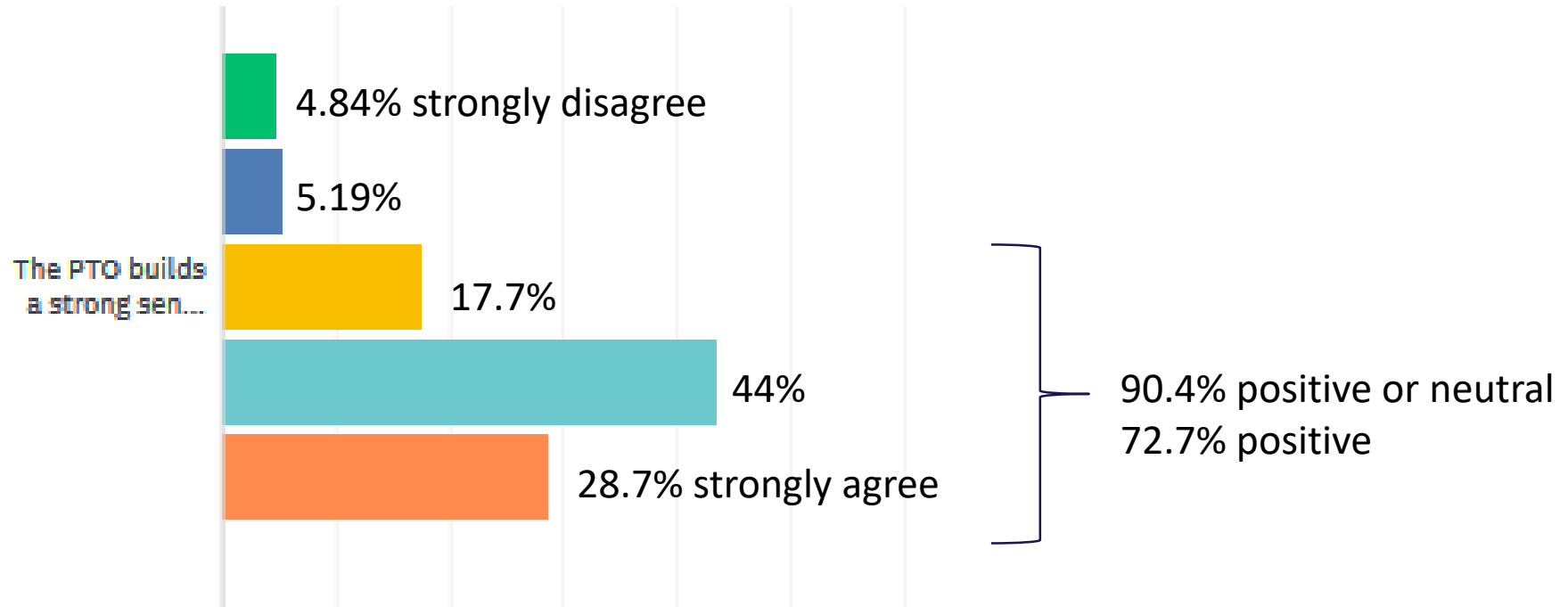




# Building Sense of Community
