- Book Fair Update
 - o Ends today at noon
 - Tues was parent night (also had dome hats there and volleyball game going on)
 - o April 1st-10th is next book fair and will do another parent night
- Fall Fundraising Update
 - \$21,727.30 (goal was only \$12,000)
- Grants Update
 - Divided grants into a fall round and a spring round (\$7,500 each round)
 - Strom reviews applications and does an approval or denial depending on district.
 - He sends to board and we take a vote
 - We had 25 grants requested
 - 16 approved (ones not approved were by Strom due to not being approved by district and a few were provided from district so didn't need grants to pay for them) 3 Kinder requests were denied along with one First, Forth, and one Middle School
 - Remaining requests are on hold to see if district will provide them
 - Majority of items were science items
 - Also had PE items and Music items for K-5
- Items have been ordered and should be here in the next few weeks
- Upcoming Spiring Night Wreath Night
 - o Nov 2nd at 6:30 at Dick's Wings
 - Can choose through website what type of wreath you want to make (Sports, Holidays, etc)
 - \$75 is cost and \$10 comes back to PVA
