



Fundraising for the first annual Palm Valley Academy Bobcat Bolt begins Monday, October 29. With your help, the school hopes to raise the funds needed to add play structures and shade to the playground. These investments will help students make the most of the physical, mental and social benefits of their recess time.

Create a Pledge Page & Start Fundraising

Register and create a pledge page for your child(ren) (each student needs his/her own pledge page) on [The Get Movin Crew website for Palm Valley Academy](#). If you have registered and are a returning user, log in and add/update the Student Information for your child(ren). To register:

1. Go to [Parent Login](#)
2. Select *Create a Parent Login*
3. Enter your name, email address, and create a password
4. Select *Create*
5. Select *+ Add Student*
6. Fill out the required Student Information fields
 - a. School - Palm Valley Academy
 - b. Grade
 - c. Classroom - Teacher's Last Name
 - d. Student First & Last Name
 - e. Student Gender
 - f. Student Goal - \$100 or more is suggested
7. Add an image of your child and a custom fundraising message (optional)
8. Agree to the TGMC webpage disclaimer and select *Add*

Once set up, your child(ren) can share their pledge page via social media and raise funds through online donations, track progress towards their individual and classroom fundraising goals, as well as send thank you messages to donors.

Your child(ren) can also raise funds by collecting cash or checks made out to Palm Valley Academy PTO. Students will receive a donation envelope that should be used to turn in cash and check donations to the school as they are received. Promptly turning in cash and check donations ensures that individual and classroom fundraising tallies stay up-to-date. Donation envelopes will be returned to students for reuse.

Fundraising efforts will continue through the day of the Bobcat Bolt on Thursday, November 8.

Fundraising Goals & Incentives

To get students excited about supporting their school, everyone will receive a Bobcat Bolt bracelet. As students reach the following fundraising goals, they will receive a prize:

- **\$50** - Mood Guy Pen
- **\$100** - Hyperlight Bouncy Ball
- **\$150** - PVA Bobcat Cinch Sak
- **\$250** - Kickball tournament with Strom/O'Keefe and a Tikiz Shaved Ice party afterwards

Bobcat Bolt Race Day - November 8

Each student will receive a Bobcat Bolt t-shirt to wear the day of the race, but students may also be asked to wear specific spirit attire that goes along with their class theme. Please make sure students wear athletic shoes and bring a water bottle on race day.

Each grade has an assigned run time (see schedule below) and all the students within that grade will participate together. Students will have 30 minutes to run/walk as many laps as they can on our Bobcat Bolt track. As students complete a lap, it will be marked on the back of their Bobcat Bolt t-shirt. Water will be available throughout the race and a healthy snack will be provided afterwards. Additional medical/nursing staff will be on site to ensure the health and well-being of all students.

Parents are welcome to come cheer on their Bobcat(s) on the sidelines. For safety reasons, there will be a pre-registration sign up for the event. All spectators will need to have [SJCS clearance](#) and show a valid state ID/driver's license to get their badge and be admitted to the event. No one will be allowed inside the school unless serving as a volunteer.
